## CAMP CLASSES

**Woodcrafts (All ages):** Woodcrafts encompasses the construction and painting of pre-cut wooden projects. Each year has a different project coordinated with the theme of the camp in addition to the ever-present birdhouse. Campers will use various hand tools to make the project.

**Arts & Crafts (All ages):** Arts & Crafts will include other crafts which do not require the use of construction tools. This could include any number of crafts from weaving to working with clay.

**Dance (All ages):** Campers will learn the basic steps and choreography to a dance number which they will be perform at Thursday nights Camp Revue.

**Guitar/Ukulele (All ages - 8 spots available):** Campers will learn the different parts of the guitar, and how to tune it. They will also learn several root chords and strumming techniques. Acoustic guitars will be provided but campers may bring their own if they choose.

**Drama (All ages):** Campers will write and perform skits based on this years' camp theme and will perform them at Thursday nights Camp Revue,.

**Soccer (All ages):** Campers will be divided in different classes based upon skill level and be taught techniques from a certified soccer coach. Whether completely new to the game, or a skilled player, the campers will certainly advance their skills on the soccer field. The camper must bring shin guards with them and cleats if they have them. Tennis shoes should be just fine if they do not have cleats.

**Games (All ages):** This class includes the participation in various camp games from eagle's nest through whatever crazy game our games coordinator comes up with to match this year's theme.

**Fishing (all ages):** Campers will learn about different types of hooks and bait, how to string a hook, the different types of fish, and, of course, plenty of practice with the rod.

**Swimming lessons (all ages):** If a camper does not yet know how to swim or just wants to learn to swim better, they can learn at camp. A certified swim instructor will teach them how to swim and float in open water.

**Camp project (all ages):** Campers will get to work on a project for the camp to stay at camp. This could include building benches for the camp fire or building a low rope course.

**First-aid (ages 10 and up):** Our camp nurse will be teaching the basics of first-aid. This course will include how to detect a medical problem (stroke, heart attack, heat exhaustion, etc.) and what to do. It will include everything from treating a bee sting to making a splint to dressing an open wound.

**Outdoor Survival (ages 10 and up):** Campers will learn the basic skills of survival such as fire building, shelter making, nature's provisions, etc. They will learn how to take things found in nature and use it to their advantage for basic necessities.

**Canoeing (ages 10 and up):** This class will teach campers the parts of a canoe and how to maneuver it in open water. Life vests will be provided, but if your child has one that they prefer, they may bring it.
